Farmers Scientist interface meet on CRA

KVK, Namakkal conducted Farmers Scientist interface meet on Climate Resilient varieties, technologies and practices at KVK campus on 28.9.2021. KVK scientists and Deputy Director (Agri), FTC



delivered lectures on importance of climate resilient technologies viz., abiotic stress tolerant varieties, crop diversification, Inter cropping systems, importance of soil testing, soil health management based on soil health card report, exsitu & insitu moisture conservation practices, better management practices for dairy, small ruminants, back yard poultry rearing & use of farm implements, farm machinary to overcome the labour shortages and also webcasted the Hon'ble Prime Minister's address & interaction with farmers . A total of 157 farmers, farm women & students were participated and benefitted.

KVK Training - Off campus & Virtual

KVK, Namakkal conducted off campus training programme on ICM practices in Small onion at Valayapatti village (04.08.21), ICM Practices in Black pepper at Adukkampatti,



Kollihills (13.08.21) and Biosecurity in field crop areas at Pallakkapalayam village (16.09.2021) in Namakkal district and demonstrated seed treatment of small onion seed var.Co(On) 6 with Arka Microbial Consortium, IISR pepper booster application, herboliv foliar spray to protect the field from wild animals. A total of 124 farmers were attended and benefitted. Also KVK Organized 4 Virtual training on ICM in minor millets, soil health management, best management practices in fish farming, integrated fish farming on 02.07.21, 15.07.21, 09.08.21 & 23.08.21 with 180 farmers.

ATMA Convergence Programme

KVK Scientists delivered technical lectures on Integrated crop management in field crops, ICM in Coconut, Organic vegetable cultivation and Green fodder production technologies in different



villages of Namakkal district on 11.08.21, 16.08.21, 17.08.21 & 24.09.21 organized by ATMA, Department of Agriculture, Namakkal district during this quarter. Also 11 exposure visits were conducted and 710 farmers benefitted.

Parthenium Awareness Camp

KVK Namakkal observed "Parthenium Awareness Week" from August 16.08.21 to 22.08.21. During this week, parthenium weeds are uprooted from KVK farm primises, farm labourers were



instructed about the illness of parthenium weeds to animals, humans and loss to agricultural crops and its control measures among KVK Trainees in various dates. A total of 145 participants were benefitted from this event.

Tribal Sub Plan at Kollihills

Tribal Sub Plan scheme was implemented by KVK, Namakkal at Gundurnadu and Vazhavanthinadu panchayat of Kollihills during 2021-22. Demonstration was conducted on Minor millets primary processing unit (Dehuller, Destoner, Aspirator, Grader, Pulverizer, sealing machine, electronic weighing balance and accessories items) for development of EDP activities at Thambapadipatti village of Kollihills on 20.07.2021. Conduced training cum awareness programme Nutrigarden with focussing





a theme on "Agriculture and Nutrition - the way of tribal agriculture" to 21 tribal farmers and farm women at TSP village Elangiyampatti on 28.07.2021 and visited Nutritional vegetable garden established under the technical guidance of KVK at KGBV school, Ariyur Kizhakkuvalavu, Kollihills. Inaugurated primary processing unit for spices and plantation crops consisting of Disc type coffee pulper, Pepper grader, Pepper dust extractor, Pepper powder making machine, Cardamom dryer and Organic shop at Elangiyampatti village on 15.09.2021 and made field visit to finger millet field to observe the performance of variety and farmers feedback. Exhibited organic spices, fruits, plantation & vegetables produced by KVK Namakkal Masila Organic farmers group in an area of 50 acre at organic shop at Masila Aruvi tourist place and also distributed PGS organic certificates to the 21 farmers. Conducted Off Campus training programme on Desi bird rearing, Vermicompost production technologies

and Organic farming practices in Paddy cultivation, value added fish products to farm women and rural youth at Maruthankulam & Elangiyampatti villages on 13.08.2021, 15.09.2021 & 30.09.2021. EDP training programme on Bee Keeping, Mushroom production was conducted in Nathukulipatti village on 30.9.2021 and observed the growth performance of desi chicken and goat distributed under EDP mode on 13.08.2021.

NFSM - CFLD Programme

Under National Food Security Mission (NFSM) - Cluster Front Line Demonstration (CFLD), KVK, Namakkal was allotted 10 ha of Groundnut, 10 ha of Castor, 20 ha of Green gram & 20 ha of Black gram for



Kharif 2021 season. A total of 150 demonstrations were undertaken in a cluster approach in potential, DFI and NICRA villages by covering 60 ha in 150 farmers field. Critical inputs viz., seeds (Green gram - CO-8, Black gram - VBN-8, Groundnut - Dharani, Castor - YRCH1), bio agents, crop boosters, IPDM inputs to all the beneficiary farmers and demonstrated seed treatment, foliar spray of crop booster, yellow sticky trap & pheromone trap installation, mechanical harvest among cluster farmers and conducted Orientation training on pulses production technology and frequent field visits. Out of 100 pulses farmers, 45 farmers (18 ha) were motivated and involved in foundation seed production by tie up with KVK Seed hub projects and department of seed certification. Kharif Groundnut field day was conducted at Kokkalai village on 14.09.2021, recorded higher pod yield of 35-40 pods/ plant and obtained farmers feedback during harvest.
