Eleventh Scientific Advisory Committee (SAC) Meeting

To create awareness among the farmers about sustainable soil health, Worldsoil day programme cum exhibition was

On campus training programme

From October to December 2017, nineteen on campus trainings were conducted at KVK, Namakkal with 655 farmers. Rice and oilseed production



technologies, tapioca, small onion production technologies, soil fertility improvement, integrated nutrient management practice, sericulture farming, agro forestry system, mass production of organic pest repellent and mealy bug parasites production, storage pest management, white pig rearing, desi chicken rearing, infertility management in dairy cattle, shrimp culture, murrel farming, gift tilapia culture were trained during these trainings.

Training with line departments

KVK Namakkal has organized 23 trainings in association with agriculture and animal husbandry departments. A total of 1224 farmers were



participated. The major themes on mushroom cultivation, integrated crop management practice, free goat and sheep farming were taught to farmers at farmer's field in different blocks of Namakkal district. Out of 23 trainings, 21 trainings with 1170 participants belongs to free goat and sheep farming. To improve the economic status of farmers with available resource goat farming has been promoted among the farmers through free training programmes.

Sponsored training programme

Two NABARD sponsored six days skill development training was conducted at KVK campus with 60 participants (30 farmers / training & 3



days / training) entitled "Organic Roof Top Vegetable Gardening" held from 12.12.2017 to 14.12.2017 and Nursery management in horticultural crops from 19.12.2017 to 21.12.2017. In these programme, farmers were practically trained on portray nursery preparation, roof top gardening and grafting, budding and layering techniques in Horticultural crops. Exposure visit was made to Uyir Organic farm, Erode, Protray Nursery Unit at Karkoodalpatti, Successful Roof top garden units formed by KVK farmers at Namakkal, Giant Orchard, Karumanthurai and Private Nursery unit at Rasipuram.

Paid training programme

KVK, Namakkal has conducted one paid training entitled "Aquaculture-Freshwater and Brackish water fish seed production a n d c u l t u r e technology" on 18.12.2017 with 23 Students. In this programme, site selection, selection



of suitable fish species, feed management, water quality monitoring, disease management, post harvest technology and value added products preparation were trained to them.

Off campus training programme

Based on the need of farmers, location specific 17 off campus trainings were conducted at farmer's field to propagate the technologies related



to Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries sectors with 507 farmers.

Zonal workshop

Two monthly zonal workshops for a g r i c u l t u r a l department officials were conducted on 10.10.17 a n d 14.11.17 at KVK, Namakkal. A total of



65 extension officials were participated. Scientist of KVK, Namakkal were delivered the technical lectures related the seasons. Major field problem in different blocks of Namakkal district were discussed and suggestions were recommended.

Exhibitions conducted/participated

KVK, Namakkal has conducted five exhibitions during SAC meeting, PPV & FRA 2001, World Soil Day 2017, Pesticides use awareness programme and TNLDA phase II programme on 07.11.2017, 30.11.17, 05.12.17, 11.12.17 and 15.12.17 respectively in this quarter. Totally 1630 f a r m e r s w e r e participated and benefitted in the exhibition. In the above exhibitions soil fertility management



inputs (kinds of organic manures, biofertilizer, inorganic fertilizers, soil amendments), PUSA STFR and Mridaparikshak Mini soil testing labs, high yielding pulses and groundnut varieties, fodder seeds, saplings, organic inputs, vegetables, flower crops, traditional plants & products, infertility management techniques, mineral supplementation, alternative feeds such as azolla, hydrophonics, clean milk production technologies were displayed. MSSRF displayed traditional crop seeds, Fertilizer Companies (IFFCO and KRIBHCO) displayed solid and liquid fertilizer, Pharmaceutical Private Companies (Intervet, Polchem, Amul, Hindustan) displayed veterinary health products, Velan Pudumai displayed farm equipment for drudgery reduction, Farm Entrepreneur (Chiyyalamman organic producers) exhibited value added milk products and by products, Araikkal displayed millet by products in the exhibition. Agriculture, Horticulture and Animal Husbandry departments and Veterinary College & Research Institute, Namakkal has also participated and exhibited important schemes available for farmers, mobile soil testing van, different stages of calf development, infertility management techniques and organic roof top gardening kit in the event. KVK Namakkal has also participated in the TNAUVAS foundation day exhibition with 85 Namakkal farmers.

Soil & water analysis & issue of soil health cards

Since October to December 2017, 160 soil samples & 29 water samples received and tested. Totally 172 soil health cards and 29 water health cards issued to



farmers with soil test based integrated fertilizer recommendation. Based on the analytical results soils were deficient in available nitrogen, zinc, boron and organic carbon. To improve the fertility status of soil, farmers were advised for practicing green manuring and biofertilizer application during training programme, field visit and issue of soil health cards.

Awards received by KVK farmer

KVK farmers namely Th.K.Senkottaiyan from Sevagoundanpalayam, Th.V.S.Rajhu from Koolipatti and Th.C.Periyasamy from Manuvakattupalayam were honored by The Vice Chancellor, TANUVAS and The Director, ATARI, Zone X during eleventh SAC meeting for best farming practice in their farms after getting proper skills from KVK. Also KVK farmers Th.K.Senkottaiyan from Sevagoundanpalayam, Th.R.Vellappagounder from Kalappanaikanpatty received best farmer award for integrated farming
